2026 SCHOLARSHIP REQUIREMENTS AND APPLICATION

1. Candidates must be of Peristian heritage, a member of the Agios Athanasios Association of Perista prior to December 31, 2025, and in good standing. (Contact Marina Stopler, mstopler@verizon.net to confirm membership).
2. Candidates must be full-time matriculated students with minimum two semesters completed (undergraduate, graduate, or postgraduate) at an accredited college or university in the USA.
3. Candidates must provide the Scholarship Committee evidence of their Scholastic Standing, including transcript records with a grade average of At least a "B", or 83 percent or 3.3 GPA. (*Note: if you cannot receive your transcript in time for the last semester you can use the latest transcript available*).
4. Documents must be official, from the college or university on their stationary in a sealed envelope or sent electronically directly from the university.
5. Candidates are to include a brief scholastic resume (including Honors and Awards, Languages, special skills, extracurricular activities, and volunteer service (Church, School, Community)).
6. Candidates must provide a typewritten one-page essay describing the reason for applying for the Scholarship and what it means to them to be of Peristian Heritage.
7. Candidates must provide a Letter of Recommendation from a college Advisor or Professor. This must be on their stationary in a sealed envelope or sent electronically directly from Advisor or Professor.
8. Applications must be completed. **Incomplete applications will not be considered.** Previous recipients of the Agios Athanasios Association Scholarship are not eligible to apply again. The decision of the Scholarship Committee will be final and cannot be contested.
9. Applications and all associated documents must be **received complete in the fashion required, no later than January 12, 2026.**
